Impassioned jazz musician and percussionist from Brussels, **DJ Gaetano Fabri** popularizes gypsy music through the club scenes throughout Europe by **blending clubbing culture with traditional music**. Coming from the acid, he started in 2000 his love affair with Balkan music and began to fuse traditional music from the Tzigane or 'Gypsy' culture, Balkan brass bands of Eastern Europe and even Klezmer and Russian folk songs. Gaetano has also played on tzigane weddings and recently even for celebrating a divorce! Fabri's remix of Siki Siki Baba by **Kocani Orkestar**, without a doubt the most incredible Macedonian brass band of this century, appears on the first volume of the now hugely popular Electric Gypsyland series and is a dance floor favourite. In 2010 Gaetano created his label **Blue Gypsy records** which emerged albums like "Smart Gypsy", "Balkan disko" and in 2012 "Balkan Circus.

On this special Night in Melusina we will have the privilege to experience life his amazing mixes of Balkan and clubbing music - **prepare yourself for some serious jumping, singing and dancing!**
